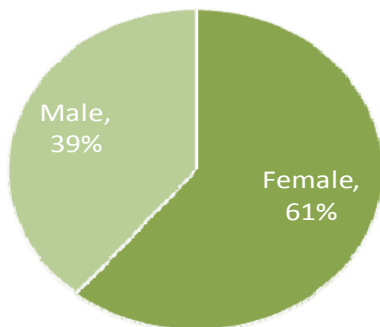

Male vs. Female

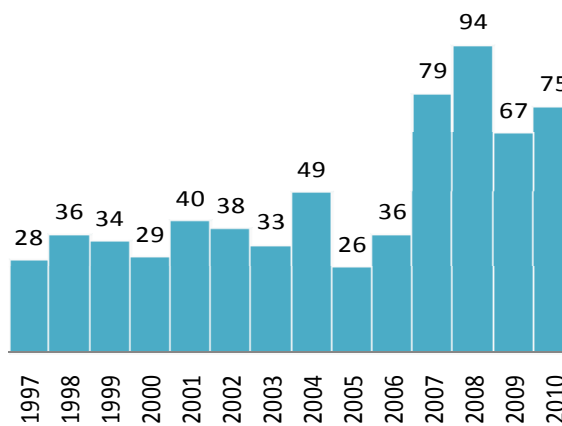


Following a national trend, more female students than male students apply for Community Foundation Scholarships.
